REFERRED TO IN PARAGRAPH 3 OF ARTICLE 4

1. For the products specified in Table A of this Annex originating in an EFTA State, Bulgaria shall abolish all customs duties on the date of entry into force of the Agreement.

2. For the products specified in Table B of this Annex originating in an EFTA State, Bulgaria shall progressively reduce all customs duties in accordance with the following timetable:

- on 1 January 1994 to 80 % of the basic duty;
- on 1 January 1996 to 40 % of the basic duty;
- on 1 January 1998 to 0 % of the basic duty.

3. For the products falling within Chapters 25 to 97 of the Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System and covered by this Agreement but not specified in Tables A and B of this Annex, which originate in an EFTA State, Bulgaria shall progressively reduce all customs duties in accordance with the following timetable:

- on 1 January 1996 to 80 % of the basic duty;
- on 1 January 1998 to 60 % of the basic duty;
- on 1 January 1999 to 45 % of the basic duty;
- on 1 January 2000 to 30 % of the basic duty;
- on 1 January 2001 to 15 % of the basic duty;
- on 1 January 2002 to 0 % of the basic duty.

4. Bulgaria shall abolish charges having equivalent effect to customs duties on the date of entry into force of the Agreement except for those charges mentioned below which shall be abolished in accordance with the following timetables:
